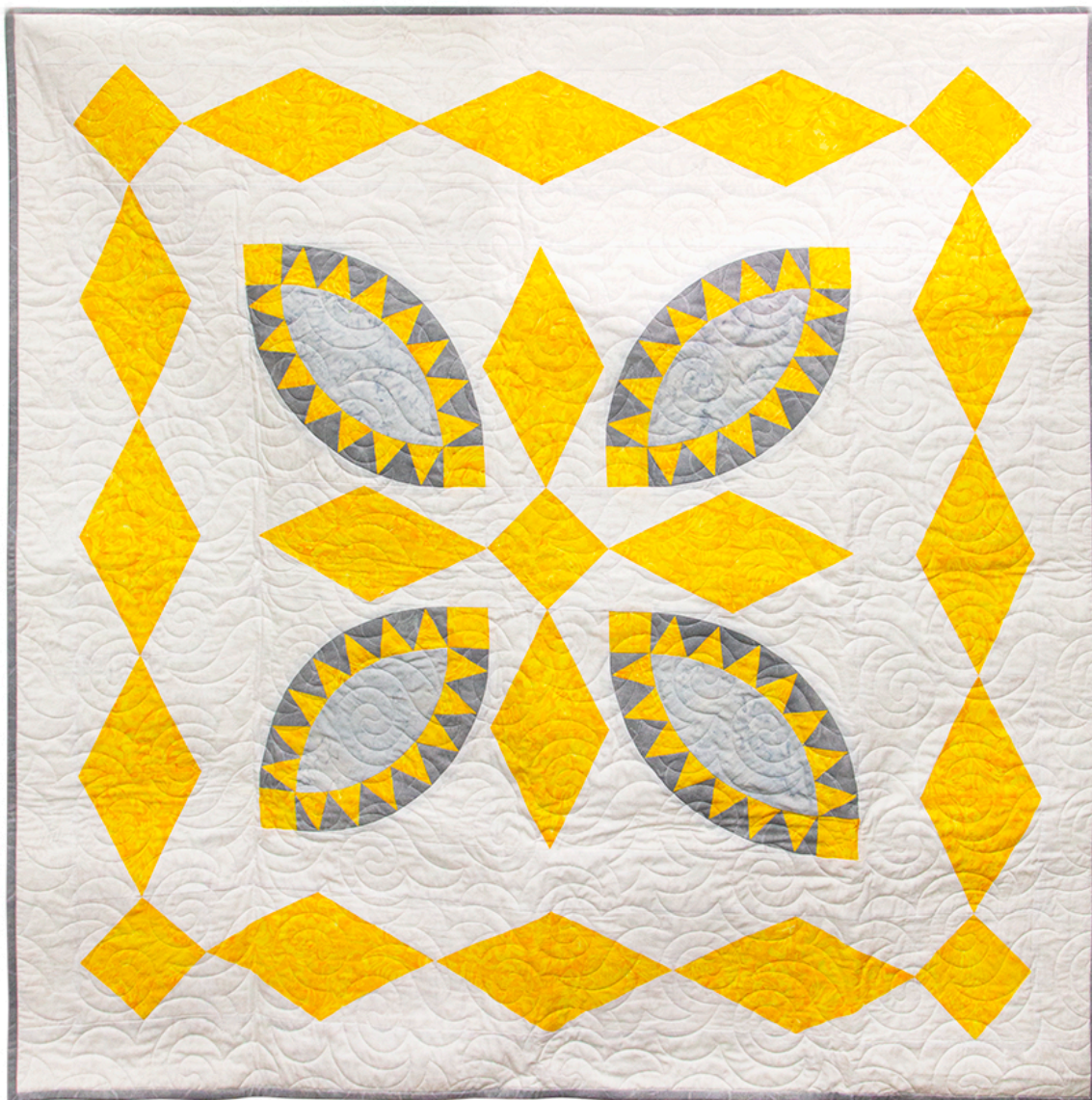


# GO! Burst of Sunshine Throw Quilt

## Dies Needed:

### GO! Qube Mix & Match Size 10" Block (55797)

- GO! Half Square Triangle-2-1/2" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Square on Point-4-1/16" (3-9/16" Finished) (Shape 6)

### GO! Qube Size 10" Companion Set — Angles (55799)

- GO! Triangles in Square-Center-5" Finished Square (Shape 13)
- GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-5" Finished Square (Shape 14)

### Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter—2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter—3" (2-1/2" Finished) (55084)
- GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)

## Fabric Requirements

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
White Background	1 5/8 yards
Yellow	3/4 yards
Medium Gray	5/8 yards
Light Gray	1/4 yard
Batting	56" x 56"
Backing	56" x 56"

## Cutting Directions

Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut
White	GO! Half Square Triangle-2-1/2" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 20—2-1/2" finished half square triangles.
	GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-5" Finished Square (Shape 14)	Cut 3—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6" widths. Sub cut into 32—5" finished triangles in square-sides.
	GO! Strip Cutter 3" (2-1/2" Finished) (55084)	Cut 8—3" x WOF strips for inner and outer borders. Sub cut 2—3" x 25-1/2" for inner vertical border, sub cut 2—3" x 30-1/2" for inner horizontal border, sub cut 2—3" x 40-1/2" for outer vertical border, and sub cut 2—3" x 45-1/2" for outer horizontal border (outer horizontal border is pieced).
Yellow	GO! Square on Point – 4-1/16" (3-3/16" Finished) (Shape 6)	Cut 1—4-1/2" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 5—5" finished squares on point.
	GO! Triangles in Square-Center-5" Finished Square (Shape 13)	Cut 2—6" x WOF strips. Use the Cut & Flip™ method. Sub cut into 16—5" finished triangles in square-center.
Light Gray	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—5-1/4" x WOF. Fold into 10-1/2" widths. Place over crescent shape and cut 4.
Yellow	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—2-3/4" x WOF. Fanfold into 2-3/4" widths. Sub cut 8—Shape B squares.
	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—2-3/4" x WOF. Fanfold into 5-1/2" widths. Sub cut 14—Shape E triangles.
White	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—10" x WOF. Fanfold into 10" widths. Sub cut 4 Shape C corners. Flip folded fabric and place over shape again and sub cut 4 more Shape C corners.
Medium Gray	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—2-3/4" x WOF. Fanfold into 3-1/2" widths. Sub cut 8—Shape D triangles and 8—Shape DR triangles.
	GO! Pickle Dish-10" Finished (55539)	Cut 1—2-3/4" x WOF. Fanfold into 6-1/2" widths. Sub cut 12—Shape F triangles.
Medium Gray	Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 5—2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

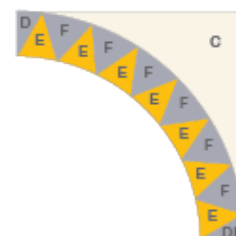
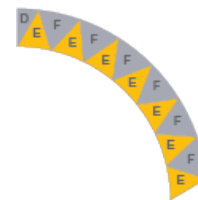
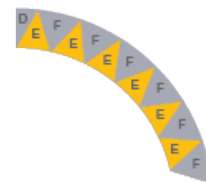
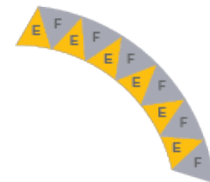
## Sewing Directions

*Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

### PICKLE DISH BLOCKS

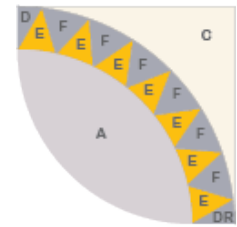
NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew shape E to F to create 12 E/F units. Press seams open. Make 12.
2. Sew E/F units together to create E/F/E/F/E/F units. Press seams open. Make 4.
3. Sew E/F/E/F/E/F units together to create the inner arch. Press seams open.
4. On the left side of the arch, add Shape D. Press towards Shape D.
5. On the right side of the arch, add shape E. Press seams open, then add shape DR. Press towards shape DR.
6. Pin and sew outer arch shape C to each of the inner arch units. Press towards shape C. Piece together with the outer arch shape C on top, and the inner arch units on the bottom, so that piece's line up.

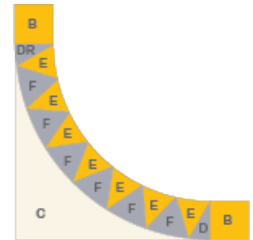




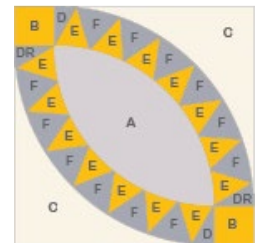
7. Sew one of the completed arch sections to shape A, press towards shape A.



8. Add shape B to both ends of the other arch unit.



9. Sew two units together to complete block. Press towards shape A. Block should measure 10-1/2" x 10-1/2".



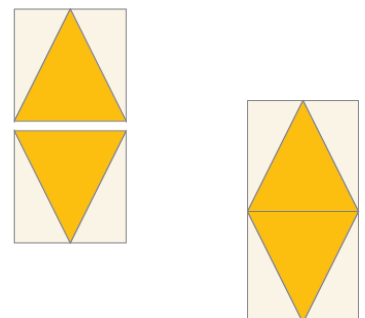
## Border Diamonds

NOTE: Directions will be for one 5" x 10" finished diamond block. Make 16 diamond unit blocks.

1. Sew one white triangle in a square side (TIS-side) (Shape 14) to each side of one yellow triangle in a square center (TIS-center) (Shape 13) as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 TIS units for each diamond.



2. Sew 2 TIS units together as shown to make a single diamond unit.



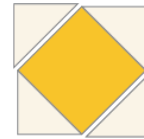
## Border Squares on Point

NOTE: Directions will be for one 5" finished block. Make 5 Square on Point blocks.

1. Sew a white 2-1/2" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to opposite sides of the 5" finished square on point (SOP) (Shape 6) as shown. Press seams open.

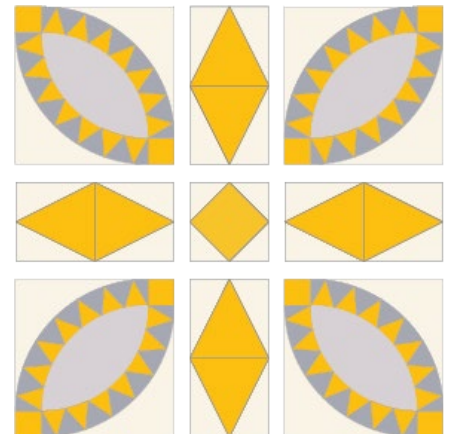


2. Sew a white 2-1/2" finished HST (Shape 5) to the remaining opposite sides of the 5" finished SOP (Shape 6) as shown. Press seams open.



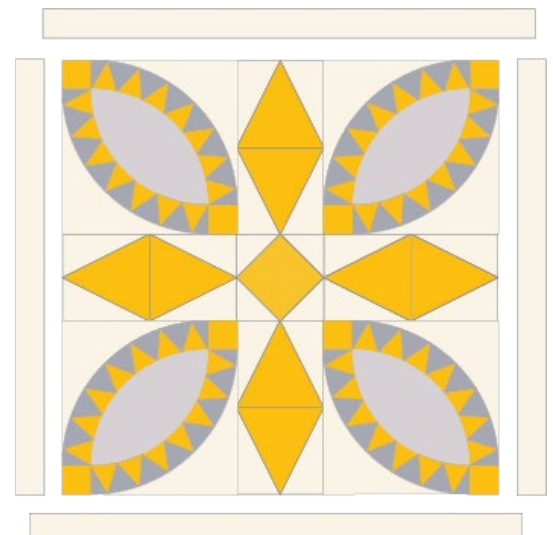
## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks and diamonds for the center of the quilt as shown. Sew blocks and diamonds together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams to one side.

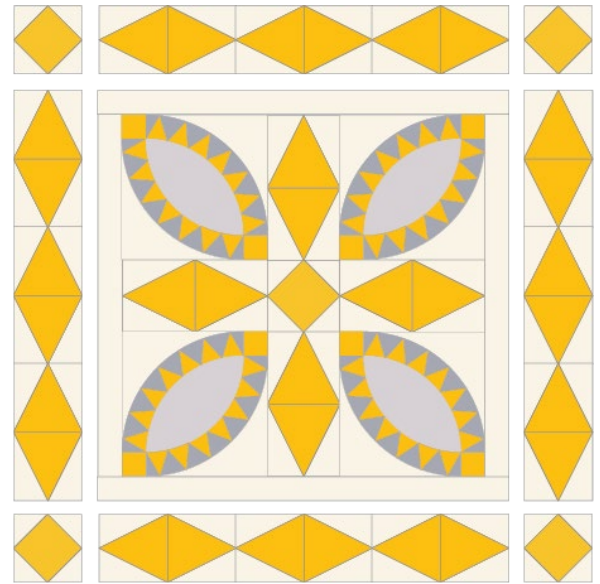


## Assemble the Inner and Outer Borders

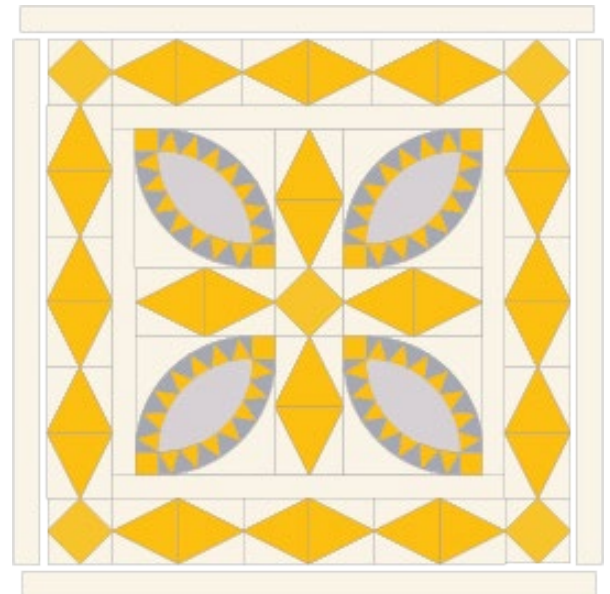
1. Cut the vertical and horizontal inner borders according to the cutting instructions. Stitch the vertical inner border to the sides of the quilt. Stitch the horizontal inner border to the top and bottom of the quilt.



2. Stitch three diamonds together as shown for the vertical border. Stitch the diamond vertical border to the quilt. Press seam allowances toward the inner border.
3. Stitch three diamonds together and a square on point to either end for the horizontal border. Stitch the triple diamond/squares on point horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seam allowances toward the inner border.



4. Cut the vertical and horizontal outer borders according to the cutting instructions. The horizontal outer border will be pieced as per the cutting instructions. Stitch the vertical outer border to the sides of the quilt. Stitch the horizontal outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.



## Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
