Chocolate, Cherries & Blueberries

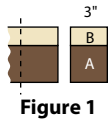
Make this off-center design combining Log Cabin blocks with appliquéd cherries and blueberries.

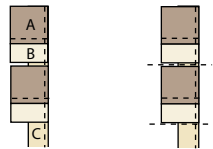
Completing the Log Cabin Blocks

Step 1. Sew an A strip to a B strip with right sides together along length; press seam toward B. Repeat to make three A-B strip sets.

Step 2. Subcut the A-B strip sets into (37) 3" A-B units as shown in Figure 1.



Step 3. Place an A-B unit on the C strip as shown in Figure 2; stitch a 1/4" seam. Continue adding A-B units to the strip, again referring to Figure 2.



Step 4. When all A-B units are stitched to the C strips, lay the stitched

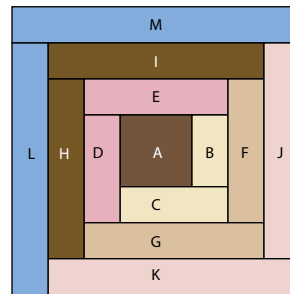
strips on your cutting mat and trim the C strip even with the A-B units as

shown in Figure 3.

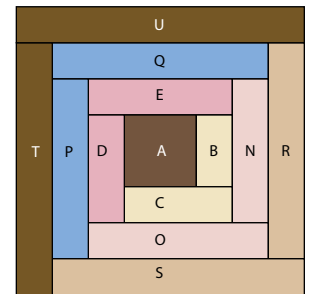
Step 5. Press each unit with seam toward C.

Step 6. Repeat Steps 3–5, adding strips D–M in alphabetical order referring to the lettered diagram in Figure 4 to complete 19 Blue Log Cabin blocks.

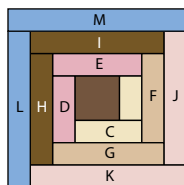

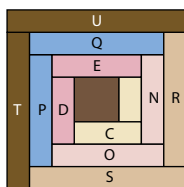

Step 7. Repeat Steps 3–5 with pieces D and E and

N–U referring to Figure 5 for piecing to complete 18 Brown Log Cabin blocks.

Completing the Appliqué

Step 1. Using a quarter, trace 46 circles on the paper side of the fusible web; fuse to the wrong side of the raspberry print. Cut out shapes on traced lines; remove paper backing.

Step 2. Repeat Step 1 with a penny to cut 41 blueberry shapes from the blueberry print; remove paper backing.

Step 3. Repeat Step 1 with the leaf shape given to cut 66 leaves as directed on pattern; remove paper backing.

Step 4. Fuse the ½"-wide fusible web tape to the wrong

side of the ½"-wide bias strips. *Note: Bias strips do not have to be joined; they can be overlapped at ends when fusing.*

Step 5. Join the V/W strips on short ends to make one long strip; press seams open. Subcut strip into one 60½" V strip and one 50½" W strip.

Step 6. Arrange and pin ½"-wide fused bias strips to make the vine on the V (side) and W (bottom) border strips, curving the bias gently referring to the Placement Diagram for positioning, stopping about 2" from the bottom end of the side border strip and leaving a 4"–6" tail to connect to the main stem on the W border after joining.

Step 7. Cut short stems 1"–1½" long from the remaining fused bias, cut in half along length to make ¼"-wide strips. Tuck the short stems under the main stem and fuse in place, working from the top to the bottom of the V and W pieces.

Step 8. Add berries and leaves to ends of short vines referring to the Placement Diagram for suggestions.

Note: The number of stems and berries and their placement can vary as you desire.

Completing the Quilt

Step 1. Join one Blue Log Cabin block with three Brown Log Cabin block as shown in Figure 6; press seam toward the Blue block. Repeat to make two block rows.

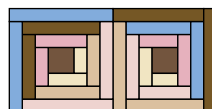

Step 2. Join the two block rows to make a four-block unit as shown in Figure 7; repeat to make six four-block units.

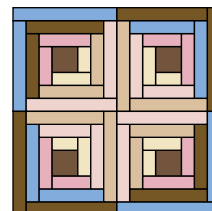

Step 3. Join the six four-block units in three rows of two units each, press seams in adjoining rows in opposite directions; join the rows. Press seams in one direction.

Step 4. Sew the appliquéd V strip to the right-side edge of the pieced unit, pinning the excess stem piece out of the way; press seam toward V.

Step 5. Sew the appliquéd W strip to the bottom edge of the pieced unit; press seam toward W.

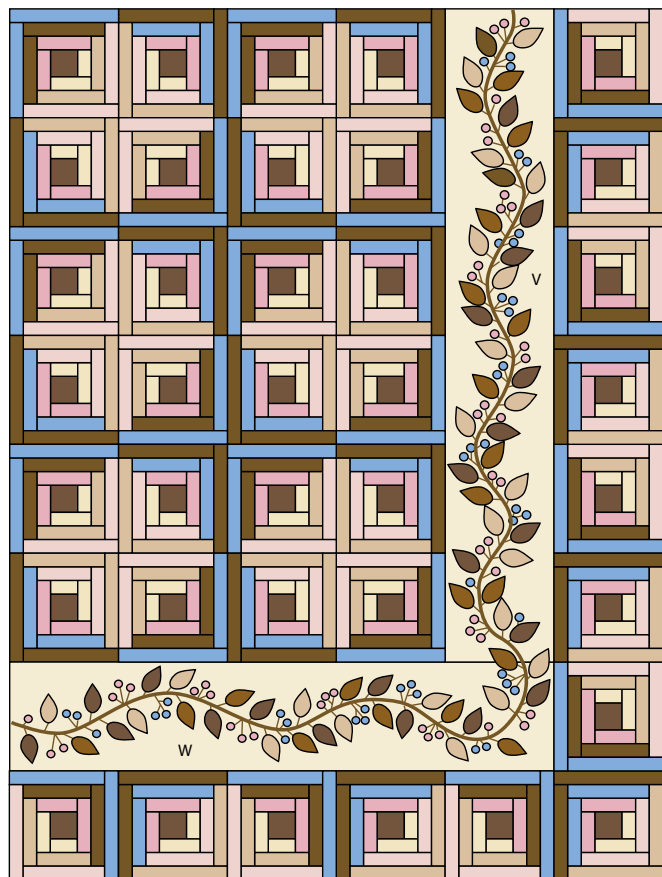
Step 6. Complete the appliqué, overlapping excess bias strip and continuing the leaf and berry designs around the corner referring to the Placement Diagram for positioning.

Step 7. Join four Blue Log Cabin blocks with three Brown Log Cabin blocks to make a side row as shown in Figure 8; press seams in one direction.

Step 8. Sew the side row to the V side of the pieced top referring to the

Placement Diagram for positioning; press seam toward the side row.

Step 9. Join three each Blue and Brown Log Cabin blocks to make the bottom row as shown in Figure 9; press seams in one direction.

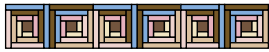

Step 10. Sew the bottom row to the W edge of the pieced top referring to the

Placement Diagram for positioning to complete the pieced top; press seam toward the bottom row.

Finishing Your Quilt

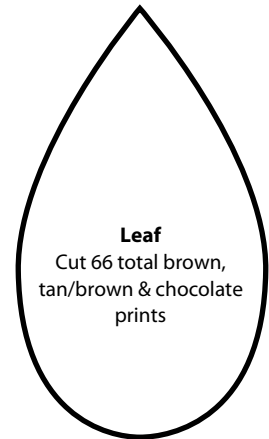
Step 1. Sandwich the batting between the completed top and prepared backing; pin or baste layers together to hold. *Note: If using basting spray to hold layers together, refer to instructions on the product container for use.*

Step 2. Quilt as desired by hand or machine; remove pins or basting. Trim excess backing and batting even with quilt top.

Step 3. Join binding strips on short ends to make one long strip. Fold the strip in half along length with wrong sides together; press.

Step 4. Sew binding to quilt edges, mitering corners and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back side and stitch in place to finish. **QW**
