Dies Needed:

GO! Crossroads-9" finished (55533)

Additional Dies (optional)

• GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" – (2" Finished) 3 Strips Die (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements: Assumes WOF is 40"

Fabric Color	Total Yardage	
Background (White)	1 5/8 yard	
Fabric A – Orange (Marmalade)	1 1/8 yard	
Fabric B – Pink (Coral)	1 1/8 yard	
Backing (Includes 3" overage for quilting)	2 7/8 yards	
Batting	51" x 51"	
Binding	1/2 yard	





Cutting Directions:

With this Block, you can cut an entire block out at one time. It will help with the organization for piecing later on – See single block cut out instructions below

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
White	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Cut 8—4" x WOF. Sub cut into 75 - 4" x 4" squares. Place 25 on Piece A of selected blade and cut. Place 50 on Piece B of selected blade and cut. Cut 8—3" x WOF. Sub cut into 100 - 3" x 3" squares. Place on Piece E of selected blade and cut.
Orange	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Cut 15—4" x WOF. Sub cut into 150 - 4" x 4" squares. Place 50 on Piece B of selected blade and cut. Place 100 on Piece C of selected blade and cut.
Pink	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Cut 15—4" x WOF. Sub cut into 150 - 4" x 4" squares. Place 50 on Piece B of selected blade and cut. Place 100 on Piece D of selected blade and cut.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" – (2" Finished) 3 Strips Die (55017)	Cut 2–8" x WOF" Strip, fold in half. Place on selected blade and cut. Make a total of 6 strips.





Single Block Cutting Directions:

* Place all squares indicated on selected blade and cut all at once. Repeat to make 25 blocks. *

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
White	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Take 3 – 4" x 4" squares. Place 1 square on Piece A and 2 squares Piece B. Take 4 – 3" x 3" squares. Cut 4 squares on Piece E.
Orange	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Take 6 – 4" x 4" squares. Place 2 squares on Piece B and 4 squares on Piece C.
Pink	GO! Crossroads-9" Finished (555333)	Take 6 – 4" x 4" squares. Place 2 squares on Piece B and 4 squares on Piece D.







Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.


NOTE: Directions will be for one 9" x 9" finished block. Make 25 Blocks total.



1. Take one (1) Piece B from each, White, Orange, and Pink. Sew, RST, with the white piece in the middle. Press seams open. Repeat to make a total of four (4) stripe units.




2. Take one (1) piece D and two (2) piece E. Orient piece D with the triangle point at the top (like a house). Place one (1) piece E in the lower right corner, lining up the triangle point in the corner. Sew a 1/4" seam and press seam open. Repeat with second piece E in the lower left corner. Repeat this step until you have eight (8) units.









3. Take one (1) piece C and two (2) units made in Step 2. Place one unit, RST, matching the long edge with a long edge of piece C. Sew 1/4" seam and press seam open. Repeat with second unit along the other long edge of piece C. Repeat this step until you make four (4) new square units.




4. Take one (1) piece A and two (2) stripe units from Step 1. Following the illustration below, orient the stripe blocks with both pink sides matching up to piece A. Sew a 1/4" seam and press seams open.



5. Take two (2) square units from Step 3 and one (1) stripe unit from Step 1. Following the illustration below, match up the orange stripe with the orange piece on the square unit. Sew a square unit on both sides of the stripe unit. * pay attention to orientation of blocks * Repeat and make a total of two (2) units.








6. Take the two (2) units from Step 5 and sew on each side of the unit made in Step 4. Press seams open.






7. Repeat Steps 1 – 6 to make a total of 25 blocks.





Assemble the Quilt Top

- 1. Lay out blocks in 5 rows of 5 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams open.
- Sew rows together. Press seams open.







Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together. 2.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- Add binding, mitering corners. 4.
