
Illusion Quilt

Quilt should measure 45.5" x 45.5" Jessica Lemon



Disclaimer: I did not make this pattern up myself; I found it somewhere online in another language and in metrics. I lost the name of it/the creator when I lost my phone. I simply did my best to figure out measurements myself and wrote new directions in English and made up measurements in inches.

Materials

You need two fabrics- one background (mine was white) and one print (blue batik in photo).

2 yards of each for the top. (This gives you 8" of wiggle room)

½ yard for binding. (This gives you just over 3" of wiggle room).

1 ½ yard for backing. (I think. I don't remember exactly how much it took me.)

<u>Cut</u>

From <u>each</u> color, cut the following:

(A) 2 - 1" x WOF

(E) 4 - 2" x WOF

(I) 1 - 3" x WOF

(B) 4 - 1 ½" x WOF

(F) 4 - 2 ½" x WOF

(C) 4 - 1 ½" x WOF

(**G**) 4 - 2 ½" x WOF

(D) 4 - 1 ³/₄ x WOF

(H) 4 - 2 ¾" x WOF

<u>Sew</u>

For the pattern, A1, B1, C1 etc will refer to strips of your color. A2, B2, C2 etc will refer to your background strips.

Sew one set together as follows:

H1, G2, F1, E2, D1, C2, B1, A2, B1, C2, D1, E2, F1, G2, H1, I2, H1, G2, F1, E2, D1, C2, B1, A2, B1, C2, D1, E2, F1, G2, H1

With the remaining srips, sew a set together as follows:

H2, G1, F2, E1, D2, C1, B2, A1, B2, C1, D2, E1, F2, G1, H2, I1, H2, G1, F2, E1, D2, C1, B2, A1, B2, C1, D2, E1, F2, G1, H2

Sew together switching which end you start sewing on. This will help prevent warping of the strips.

Cut

From the strip set that starts with color, cut the following:

- (**J**) 4 strips at 1 1/4"
- (**K**) 4 strips at 1 3/4"
- (L) 4 strips at 2 1/4"
- (M) 4 strips at 2 3/4"

From the strip set that starts with your background fabric, cut the following:

(N) 2 strips at 1"

(Q) 4 strips at 2 ½"

(O) 4 strips at 1 ½"

(R) 1 strip at 3"

(P) 4 strips at 2"

<u>Sew</u>

Arrange and sew the strips as follows:

M, Q, L, P, K, O, J, N, J, O, K, P, L, Q, M, R, M, Q, L, P, K, O, J, N, J, O, K, P, L, Q, M

Sew together switching which end you start sewing on. This will help prevent warping of the strips.

Backing

You will need 1.5 yds backing for this quilt. I think. Again, I don't remember how much it took me.

Binding

Cut 5 strips at 2.5" x WOF (need 12.5" total).
