Use monochromatic prints and one matching solid and be amazed at the effect you can create. Choose Jinny Beyer's Monochrome fabric line, or substitute your own choices.

**Size:** 73½" × 73½" **Blocks:** 9 (18") blocks

#### **MATERIALS**

**NOTE:** Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the Monochrome collection by Jinny Beyer for RJR Fabrics.

- 6 yards red stripe for blocks and outer border
- 1 yard red solid for blocks and binding

1¾ yards white print #1

3/8 yard white print #2

34 yard light red print

1 yard medium red print

34 yard dark red print

Template material

5 yards backing fabric

Full-size quilt batting



Jinny Beyer is a world-renowned fabric and quilt designer, author, and teacher. She is well-known for her distinctive border print fabrics and her 150-piece Quilters Palette fabric collection. Jinny's most recent book is the *Quilter's Album of Patchwork Patterns*, an encyclopedia of more than 4,050 blocks with historical information and instructions for drafting the blocks in any size.

#### **CUTTING**


Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. To make a template for A triangle, cut a 5%" square of template plastic in half diagonally.

#### From red stripe, cut:

- 1 (90"-long) piece. From this piece cut:
  - 4 (2¾"-wide) **lengthwise** strips, centering stripe in each, for inner borders.
  - 4 (6"-wide) **lengthwise** strips, centering stripe in each, for outer borders.

### From remainder of red stripe, cut:

• 5 (6"-wide) **lengthwise** strips, centering stripe in each. From strips, cut 36 Motif #1 A triangles from a repeating motif along 1 long edge of each strip (*Cutting Diagram*); cut 36 Motif #2 A triangles from a second repeating motif along opposite edge of each strip.



**Cutting Diagram** 

#### From red solid, cut:

- 8 ( $2\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide) strips for binding.
- 5 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.

#### From white print #1, cut:

- 6 (5%"-wide) strips. From strips, cut 36 (5%") squares. Cut squares in half diagonally to make 72 half-square A Triangles.
- 9 (2½"-wide) strips. Piece strips to make 4 (2½" × 90") middle borders.

#### From white print #2, cut:

• 5 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.

#### From light red print, cut:

• 10 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.

#### From medium red print, cut:

• 15 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.


#### From dark red print, cut:

• 10 (2"-wide) strips for strip sets.

### PIECED DIAMOND ASSEMBLY


**NOTE:** Refer to *Sew Easy: Pieced Diamonds* on page 36 for detailed instructions.

1. Join 1 white print #2 strip, 1 light red print strip, and 1 medium red print strip, offsetting strips 1½" as shown in *Strip Set* #1 Diagram. Make 5 Strip Set #1. Trim left end of each strip set at a 45-degree angle. From strip sets, cut 72 (15%"-wide) segments.




Strip Set #1 Diagram

2. In the same manner, make 5 Strip Set #2, using 1 light red print strip, 1 medium red print strip, and 1 dark red print strip in each (Strip Set #2 Diagram). From strip sets, cut 72 (15%"-wide) segments.

**3.** Make 5 Strip Set #3 using 1 medium red print strip, 1 dark red print strip, and 1 red solid strip (*Strip Set #3 Diagram*). From strip sets, cut 72 (15%"-wide) segments.

**4.** Join 1 #1 segment, 1 #2 segment, and 1 #3 segment as shown in *Pieced Diamond Diagram*. Make 72 Pieced Diamonds.

#### **BLOCK ASSEMBLY**


1. Join 1 Motif #1 A Triangle, 1
Pieced Diamond, and 1 white
print #1 A Triangle as shown
in *Unit Diagram*. Make 36 Units
using Motif #1 A triangles and 36
Units using Motif #2 A Triangles.



Unit Diagram




**2.** Join 2 Units, using 1 with Motif #1 and 1 with Motif #2, as shown in *Quadrant Assembly Diagrams*. Make 36 Quadrants.




**Quadrant Assembly Diagrams** 

**3.** Lay out 4 Quadrants as shown in Block Assembly Diagram, noting that Motif #1 is always at block corner and Motif #2 in center.

**4.** Join Quadrants into rows; join rows to complete 1 block (*Block Diagram*). Make 9 blocks.




Block Diagram

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **1.** Referring to *Quilt Top Assembly Diagram*, lay out blocks. Join into rows; join rows to complete quilt center.
- 2. Join 1 inner border, 1 middle border, and 1 outer border, matching centers, to make 1 Border Strip Set. Make 4 Border Strip Sets.
- **3.** Referring to *Sew Easy: Mitered Borders* on page 30, add Border Strip Sets to quilt, mitering corners.





Quilt Top Assembly Diagram




#### KIT AVAILABLE

#### **FINISHING**

- 1. Divide backing into 2 (2½-yard) lengths. Cut 1 piece in half lengthwise to make 2 narrow panels. Join 1 narrow panel to each side of wider panel; press seam allowances toward narrow panels.
- **2.** Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Quilt shown was quilted with a meandering feather design (*Quilting Diagram*).
- Join 2¼"-wide red print strips into 1 continuous piece for straight-grain French-fold binding. Add binding to quilt. ※

## Pieced Diamonds



Follow these strip piecing instructions to make pieced diamonds for *Fractured Star* on page 32.

- **1.** Join strips, offsetting them by 1½" at left end as shown (*Photo A*).
- **2.** Trim left end of strip set at 45-degree angle. Place 15%" line of ruler on angled edge of strip set; cut 1 segment (*Photo B*). Continue in this manner to cut desired number of segments.
- **3.** Layer 1 Strip Set #1 segment and 1 Strip Set #2 segment with right sides facing. Place pin at each seam allowance (*Photo C*). Join strip set segments.

#### Sew Smart™

Stick pin straight into seam ¼" from edge of top piece. Pin should exit seam of bottom piece ¼" from edge. — Liz

**4.** In the same manner, add strip set #3 segment to complete pieced diamond *(Photo D)*.
