## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 62" x 70"

Finished Block Size 8 " $x$ 8"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

$3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm ) blue main (C3240 Blue)
$3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm ) yellow main (C3240 Yellow)
$5 / 8$ yard ( 50 cm ) blue medallion (C3241 Blue)
$5 / 8$ yard ( 50 cm ) yellow medallion (C3241 Yellow)
$3 / 8$ yard ( 30 cm ) blue woven (C3242 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) brown woven (C3242 Brown)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) yellow woven (C3242 Yellow)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) blue circle (C3243 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) yellow circle (C3243 Yellow)
$3 / 8$ yard ( 30 cm ) multi checkers (C3244 Multi)
$3 / 8$ yard ( 30 cm ) yellow checkers (C3244 Yellow)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) blue zig zag (C3245 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 20 cm ) yellow zig zag (C3245 Yellow)
$3 / 4$ yard ( 70 cm ) off white solid (C100-02 Off White)
Binding $5 / 8$ yard $(60 \mathrm{~cm})$
Backing 4 yards ( 3.6 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

## Indie Block

Cut 6 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ from blue woven Cut 24 squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " from blue woven Cut 3 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from brown woven Cut 12 squares $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " from brown woven Cut 1 square $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{1 / 2 "}$ from yellow woven Cut 4 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ from yellow woven Cut 3 squares $4 \frac{1}{2} / \prime \times 4 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ from blue circle Cut 12 squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 22^{1 / 2}$ " from blue circle Cut 4 squares $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ from yellow circle Cut 16 squares $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2^{1 / 1 / 2 "}$ from yellow circle Cut 1 square $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from blue zig zag Cut 4 squares $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ from blue zig zag Cut 2 squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from yellow zig zag Cut 8 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ from yellow zig zag Cut 80 rectangles $21 / 2 " \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " from off white solid

## Border 1

Cut 2 strips $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF from yellow medallion
Cut 2 strips $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF from blue medallion

## Border 2

Cut 3 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF from yellow checkers
Cut 3 strips $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF from multi checkers

## Border 1

Cut 3 strips $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF from yellow main Cut 3 strips $71 / 2 " \times$ WOF from blue main

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

## Indie Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to the quilt photo for fabric placement. Sew 5 assorted print $21 / 2$ " squares, 4 off white solid $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ rectangles, and 1 assorted print $41 / 2$ " square together to create the Indie Block. Repeat to create 20 Indie Blocks.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for block placement. Lay out Indie Blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be 401/2". Top and bottom borders should be 421/2".

## Border 2

Side borders should be 501/2". Top and bottom borders should be 481/2".

## Border 3

Side borders should be $561 / 2$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $621 / 2$ ".
Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Indie Chic Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
