


Quilt Size 51 1/2" x 57 1/4" (approx.)

#### Instruction

1. Make the hexagon template including the ¼" seam allowances. Cut the numbers of hexagons from each fabric indicated below. You will cut all the partial hexagons in whole shape first. (You can trim the excess after you sew them together)

Number of hexagons			Number of hexagons
Fabric A	6	Fabric G	6
Fabric B	40	Fabric H	6
Fabric C	6	Fabric I	6
Fabric D	6	Fabric J	49
Fabric E	6	Fabric K	69
Fabric F	6		

- 2. Mark the ¼" mark on the wrong side of the hexagon fabrics, where you start and stop sewing. Making the finished size template will speed up this process.
- 3. Using a design wall or floor space, arrange the hexagons referring to the design.
- 4. Sew the hexagon blocks into columns, starting and stopping at 1/4" mark and backstitch.
- 5. Sew the columns together. Again, starting and stopping at ¼" mark of each hexagon. Try to avoid sewing over the seams. If you work from left to right columns adding one at a time, it will make easier to work with bulkiness.
- 6. Press all the seams in one direction.
- Cut out the excess to make the quilt top in rectangle. Baste the top, batting, and backing together, and quilt as you desire.
- 8. Cut six 2 ½" strips from Fabric B for binding. Piece them together for the length, then bind the quilt to complete.
