Star Sampler Block #1



Connie: I was asked to make up a 12 inch finished star block and here is what I came up with. The beautiful fabrics used are <u>Marblehead Venetian Glass</u> by Ro Gregg for <u>Fabri-Quilt</u>. Fat quarters work perfectly for this!



Here is my star block and the cutting directions:




I like to stitch my HSTs (half square triangles) as shown. It is also a good idea to trim them and make sure they measure 2 1/2" inch square after you have stitched them.





Cut all 2 7/8" squares on the diagonal

or stitch a scant 1/4" seam on both sides and then cut on diagonal




The diagram shows where the pieces will go in the block.







Placement of the corner sections.
