#### **Dies Needed:**

GO! Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)

**GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)** 

GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

**GO! Strip Cutter-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)** 

## **Fabric Requirements:**

Fabric Color	Total Yardage	
8 Gradient colors from Off White to Red SOLIDS*	1/4yd of EACH (Numbered 1-8)	
White	1yd	
Red inner border	1/4yd	
Binding Fabric	1/3yd	
Batting	38" x 38"	
Backing	40" x 40"	

<sup>\*</sup>If you are not using solids, you will need to cut 5 Right side up and 4 right side down of every other color, then 5 Right side down and 4 right side up of the alternate colors.





## **Cutting Directions:**

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
8 Gradient Colors	Prairie Star Shape A	Cut 1—7-3/4" WOF strip (Width of Fabric). Fanfold into 6-1/2" sections and lay over 9 of shape A (row 2, 3 and part of row 4) and cut out 36 of EACH color.
White	Prairie Star Shape B	Cut 2—5" WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" sections and cut out 16—B squares.
White	Prairie Star Shape C	Cut 2—7" WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" sections and cut out 16—C triangles.
White	2 1/2" Strip cutter die	Cut 4—2-1/2" WOF strips with die.
Inner Border Red	1 1/2" Strip cutter die	Cut 4—1-1/2" WOF strips with die.






#### **Sewing Directions:**


Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.


### **Prairie Star Block. (Make 4)**

- 1. Follow the chart below and lay out the block pieces on your table before starting to make sure they are placed correctly and work on one star tip at a time before moving on to keep track of pieces! The colors rotate around in a clockwise motion.
- 2. Sew 9 A diamond shapes together following the color placement as shown.



- 3. Repeat with remaining star tips.
- 4. Sew star tips together with 4 B squares and 4 C triangles as shown pivoting with the needle down at the Y seams.









#### **Assemble the Quilt Top**

- Lay out blocks in 2 rows of 2 blocks rotating each block 90 degrees as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows.
- 2. Sew rows together.
- 3. Trim 2 inner border strips to 28-1/2" and sew to sides of quilt. Press toward border strips now and throughout.
- 4. Trim 2 remaining inner border strips to 30-1/2" and sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- 5. Trim 2 outer border strips to 30-1/2" and sew to sides of quilt.
- 6. Trim 2 remaining border strips to 34-1/2" and sew to top and bottom of quilt

### **Quilting and Finishing**

- 1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- Add binding (made from 4—2 1/2" WOF Strips), mitering corners.
