

GO! Bargello Music Quilt

Finished Size: 50" x 56"



Fabrics used in quilt are from Moda Metropolis Basic Gray & Moda First Crush.



Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Music Medley (55482)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Assorted Dark Black Prints	1/4 yards each of 4 fabrics
Assorted Medium Gray Prints	1/4 yards each of 6 fabrics
Assorted Light Gray Prints	1/4 yards each of 6 fabrics
Assorted Dark Red Prints	1/4 yards each of 2 fabrics
Assorted Medium Red Prints	1/4 yards each of 2 fabrics
Assorted Light Red Prints	1/4 yards each of 5 fabrics
Assorted White Prints	1/4 yards each of 3 fabrics
Black	1/4 yard
Batting	58" x 64"
Backing	58" x 64"
Binding	1/2 Yard
Fusible	1/4 yard

Cutting Directions:

**NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.*

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
All Prints	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 1—6" x width of fabric (WOF) strips of each of the 28 colors. Sub cut into 2—2-1/2" x WOF strips each with total of 28 strips.
*Black	GO! Music Medley (55482)	Cut 1—6"W x 2-1/2" and sub cut 1—of Treble Clef. Cut 2—4"W x 3-1/2"H rectangle and sub cut 2—single bar note. Cut 4—3-1/2"W x 2-1/2"H rectangle and sub cut 4—eighth notes. Cut 3—3-1/2"W x 2"H rectangles and sub cut 3—quarter notes.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 1—18" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 8-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 6—2-1/2" finished strips.

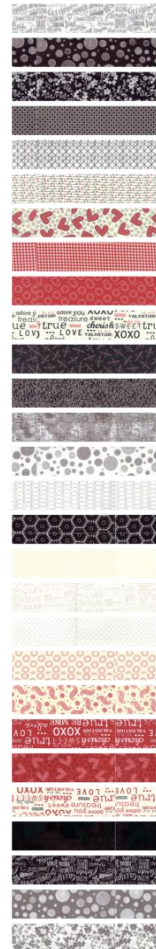
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Strip Set

NOTE: Directions will be for one 28 row finished strip set. Make 2 strip sets.

1. Lay out the 28 strips according to diagram.
2. Sew the strips together lengthwise, alternating the start end for each row. Alternating the start of the row will help prevent your strips from bowing. Press the seams to one side as you sew each strip.
3. Fold the strip set in half lengthwise and trim both ends even.
4. Sew the top and bottom of the strip set together to form a tube.
5. When both tubes are completed, flatten the tubes and make a straight edge on one side.
6. Cut 6—3-1/2", 12—2-1/2" and 5—2" wide strips from the tubes. Set the left over tube fabric aside. You can use it to make a pillow to go with you quilt!
7. Lay out the rows of tubes as follows: 2—3-1/2", 6—2-1/2", 5—2", 6—2-1/2" and 4-3-1/2".
8. Take a seam ripper and remove the stitches from the first row between the top and bottom strip color using the diagram as a guild.
9. Continue opening the seams of each row moving up a color until the 12th row, then start moving down a color.
10. Press every other row in the opposite direction. Sew the rows together nesting the seams where they met. Press each row to one side after sewing.
11. Arrange your music notes in a pleasing manner throughout the light part of the quilt.
12. Applique edges as desired. Detailed instructions using machine embroidery are included with the free machine embroidery download found at www.accuquilt.com/musicmedley55482.



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
