Dies Needed:

GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
BURGUNDY	7/8 yard
ORANGE	1 1/4 yards
GREEN	1 yard
WHITE	3 1/2 yards
Batting	63" x 63"
Backing	63" x 63"

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
BURGUNDY	GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)	Cut 3—7-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5-3/4" widths. Sub cut 52—A shapes.
ORANGE	GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)	Cut 3—7-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5-3/4" widths. Sub cut 68—A shapes.
ORANGE	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/4" (1-3/4" Finished) (55053)	Cut 6—2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
GREEN	GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)	Cut 4—7-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5-3/4" widths. Sub cut 88—A shapes.
WHITE	GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)	Cut 6—6" x WOF strip. Cut into 3-7/8" widths. With fabric layers right sides up, sub cut 52—B and 52 Br shapes.
WHITE	GO! Arkansas Traveler-12" Finished (55558)	Cut 6—7" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 4-1/4" widths. Sub cut 52—C shapes.
WHITE	Rotary Cutter	Cut 1—18-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub cut 2—18-1/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally for side setting triangles.
WHITE	Rotary Cutter	Cut 1—9-3/8" x WOF strips. Sub cut 2—9-3/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonally for corner setting triangles.
WHITE	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 5—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together into one long strip. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 51-3/8" strips and 2—2-1/2" x 55-3/8" for borders.

Note: Label each shape cut as soon as possible to avoid confusion.

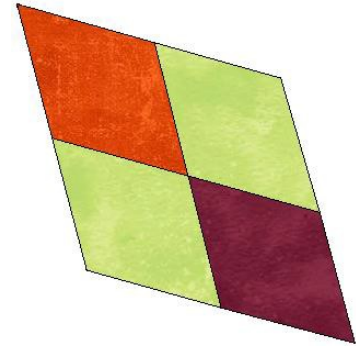
Sewing Directions:

Use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

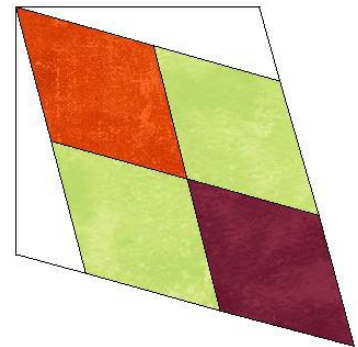
ARKANSAS TRAVELER BLOCK A

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Please also refer to die package instructions.

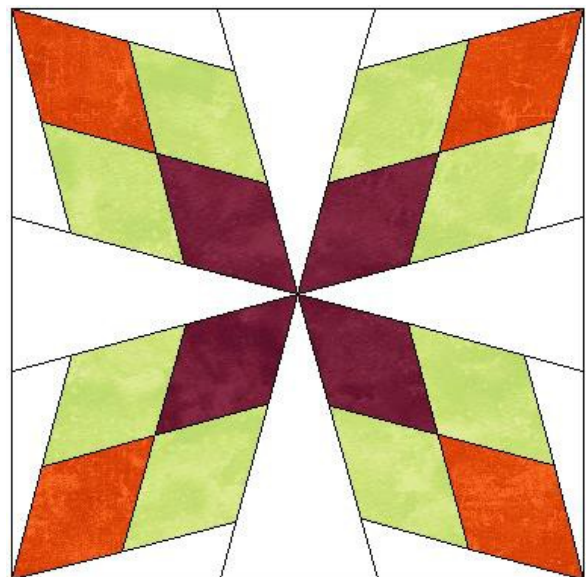
1. Sew together one burgundy A, one orange A and two green A shapes together.
2. Make 4 AAA units.



3. Sew one white B and one white Br onto one AAA shape. Repeat for the other AAA units.

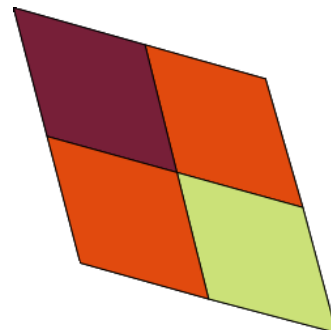


4. Layout four white C shapes and 4 AAABBr units and sew together into one Arkansas Traveler Block A.
5. Make 9 Arkansas Traveler Block A.

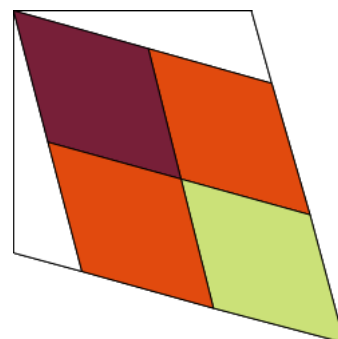


ARKANSAS TRAVELER BLOCK B

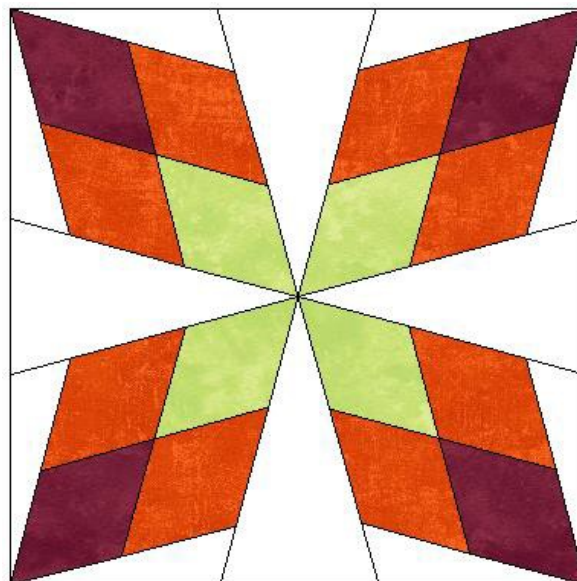
6. Sew together one burgundy A, one green A and two orange A shapes together.
7. Make 4 AAA units.



8. Sew one white B and one white Br onto one AAA shape. Repeat for the other AAA units.



9. Layout four white C shapes and 4 AAABBr units and sew together into one Arkansas Traveler Block B.
10. Make 4 Arkansas Traveler Block B.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out 9 Block A, 4 Block B, 8 white side setting triangles and 4 white corner triangles as shown. Sew blocks together in each diagonal row. Sew rows together to complete the quilt center.
2. Sew one white 2-1/2" x 51-3/8" strip to opposite sides of the quilt center.
3. Then, sew one white 2-1/2" x 55-3/8" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
