Block Assembly

Creating the Ornament Blocks

Finished block size 12"

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of (4) BB 3" squares.
2. Place (1) BB square on top of a corner of (1) A 10 1/4" square, RST.
3. Sew on drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Press back, forming the corner.



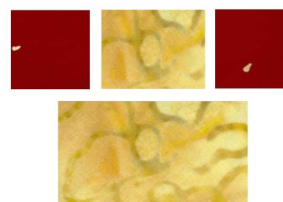
4. Repeat for each corner.



5. Sew (1) BB 8 1/4" triangle to the (3) sides of the square as shown. Press.



6. To assemble the remaining corner, sew (1) BB 7/8" square to either side of (1) CC 7/8" x 1 1/4" square to create the Tip Unit.
7. Sew (1) CC 1 3/4" x 2" rectangle to the bottom of the Tip Unit to create the Hook Unit.





- Sew (1) BB 2 1/8" x 5 1/4" rectangle to either side of the Hook Unit.



- Position (1) BB 4 1/2" triangle in the middle of the top side of the Hook Unit as shown, then stitch and press the triangle back towards the corner to complete the Corner Unit.

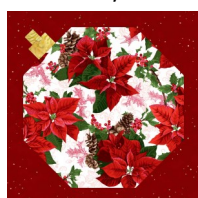


- Sew the Corner Unit on the remaining corner to complete (1) A Ornament Block. Square to 12 1/2".

- Repeat Steps 1 to 10 to complete the Ornament Blocks shown.

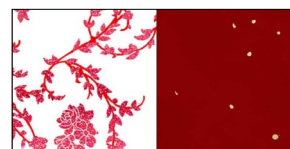

Creating the Chain Blocks

Finished block size 12"

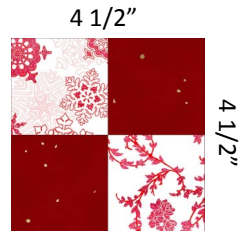
- Sew (1) R 2 1/2" square to (1) BB 2 1/2" square. Press to the BB square.

Sew (1) O 2 1/2" square to (1) BB 2 1/2" square, pressing again to the BB square.





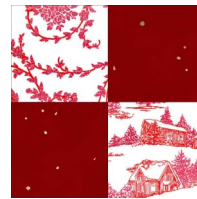
2. Arrange the two-patch units into a four-patch as shown and stitch together. Square to 4 1/2". Repeat to make (20) OR four-patches. Repeat to make (20) OM four-patches and (20) RM four-patches.

3. Arrange (4) RO four-patches, (4) BB 4 1/2" squares, and (1) M 4 1/2' square as shown. Sew together each row, then sew rows together to create (1) Chain Block A. Press towards the BB squares. Press row seams open. Square to 12 1/2".



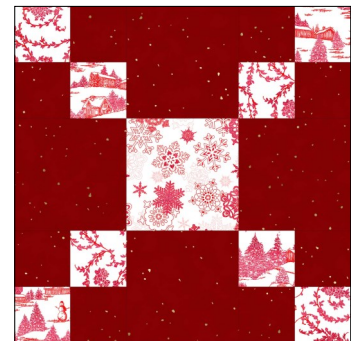
3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make Chain Blocks as shown.

Assembling the Quilt Center

1. Arrange Chain Blocks and Ornament Blocks together in rows as shown in Quilt Assembly Diagram.
2. Sew each row together. Press even rows to the right and odd rows to the left.
3. Sew rows together. Press rows seams down. Quilt Center should measure 60 1/2" x 72 1/2".

Quilt Assembly

1. Sew (4) 3" x WOF strips together in pairs. Trim each pair to 3" x 72 1/2". Sew (1) pair to each side of Quilt Center.
2. Sew (3) 2" x WOF strips together. Cut (2) 2" x 65 1/2" strips and sew to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
3. Arrange (15) 5 1/2" squares in a column as shown in the Quilt Assembly diagram. Stitch together, creating the left side border. Press seams in the same direction. Repeat to create the right, top, and bottom borders.



4. Sew the left and right pieced borders to Quilt Center. Sew remaining pieced borders to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
5. Layer backing, batting, and the quilt top.
6. Baste, then quilt as desired. Bind with X 2 1/4" strips.
