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Layout Cutting Directions



Background Sandstone



- 8 strips 2.5" x 6.5"

Marker - Teal

TIP: CUT smaller pieces from strips After longer pieces are cut

- 6 strips 3.5" x 12.5"
- 8 strips 2" x 15.5"
- 16 strips 2.5" x 6.5"
- 4 squares 7" x 7" (for Half Square Triangles)
- 16 strips 2" x 3.5" (for stars)
- 16 squares 2" x 2" (for stars)

Maize- Gold

- 4 squares 3.5" x 3.5"
- 32 squares 2" x 2"



Border

- 2 borders 6.5" x 54.5"
- 2 borders 6.5" x 60.5"
- 4 squares 7" x 7" (for Half Square Triangles)

Variety

When all the blocks are done Cut up what is left into

- 20 squares of a variety of prints 3.5" x 3.5"

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Directions:

1) Draw a diagonal line on each 2" Maize squares Make 32




Step (2) Flying Geese Unit

1) Following the diagram,

Place a Maize square on 2" x 3.5" sandstone rectangle


- 2) Sew on the line.
- 3) Flip over and press, check the back to be sure it matches up to the rectangle
- 4) Trim away the excess corner fabric behind the triangle. Leave a 1/4" seam.
- 3) Make 16 Measures 2" x 3.5"




3) Following the diagram, repeat step 2 for the second square to make the flying geese

Make 16

Measures 2" x 3.5"








4) Following the diagram use 4 of the 2" sandstone squares, 4 flying geese from above,

And a 3.5" x 3.5" maize square.


Make a Star

Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

Make 4 units







5) Following the diagram sew the strip set together using 2 sandstone 2.5" x 6.5" strips and


1 Teal 2.5" x 6.5" strip. Measures 6.5" x 6.5"

Make 8 units




6) Following the diagram alternate 2 strip sets and a star unit Measures 6.5" x 18.5"

Make 4 units









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Directions

7) Following the directions for half square triangles (HST) on the last page, use the 7" x 7"

Sandstone and the 7" x 7" border fabric Measures 6.5" x 6.5"


Make 8 units




8) Following the diagram make the star points using 2 HST from above


Measures 6.5" x 12.5"

Make 4 units




9) Following the diagram alternate blocks and the 3.5" x 12.5" Strips and one unit from above Measures 12.5" x 21.5" Make 1 of each units shown





10) When all the blocks are made
Use the 3.5" x 3.5" squares from the left over fabric
Follow the diagram using 5 of the 3.5" x 3.5"
Squares and 2 sandstone 2" x 15.5" strips
Measures 6.5" x 15.5"
Make 4 units



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


Directions:

11) Following the diagram sew the 4 corner sections using blocks, 3.5" x 12.5" background Strips from step #6 and units built with the 3.5" squares from step #10.


Measures 18.5" x 21.5"


Make 1 of each corner unit shown




Each Unit has a different block

TIP: put on your design wall to see placement Following the diagram on page 1 or page 7.








12) Following the diagram sew a unit from step #8 to each side of the center block. Measures 12.5" x 24.5"




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Layout Cut Sizes


13) Following the diagram sew Sections together Sew the 54.5" borders to the sides Sew the 60.5" borders to the top and bottom Measures 60.5" x 66.5"



Make HST

- Pair a dark and light fabric For the big star




Step A

- Draw a line on the back of all the light squares




Step B

- Layer the dark and light square
- Sew a ¼" seam on both Sides of the drawn line



Step C

Cut on the drawn Line for 2 HST



Step D

Trim squares to 6.5" x 6.5" using a square ruler with a diagonal line placed on the Seam.
