Faux Triple Ruffle Pillow Instructions

Finished Pillow Size: Approximately 21 x21" - Fits 14" pillow form



Required Materials:

1/2 yard pillow print (for pillow front and back)

16 x 16" piece of batting

1/4 yard 1st ruffle print

1/4 yard 2nd ruffle print

1/2 yard 3rd (outer) ruffle print

Cutting Instructions:

For the top and the back of the pillow, follow the diagram below and cut a 15" square pillow top from the center of the fabric. The 2 sides will be used for the backing – do not cut off the selvages.



Ruffle Cutting:

Cut the first ruffle print 3 @ 2 1/2" WOF

Cut the second ruffle print 3 @ 1 3/4" WOF

Cut the third ruffle print 3 @ 4 3/4" WOF

Sewing instructions:

Take the first ruffle and sew short edges together of all 3 pieces to make 1 long strip. Repeat this process with the second ruffle and third ruffle prints so that you have 1 long strip of each ruffle print.

Sew the silver and red strips right sides together along the long edge using a ¼" seam allowance, and press the seam towards the red print. Sew the black strip onto the silver, and press seams towards the silver.

Trim off the short edges of your ruffle unit so that they are straight. Sew those two short edges right sides together, so that you have a large circle. To make your ruffle, fold the unit in half long-ways, with the wrong sides together so that the raw edges meet, then iron very flat. Using a shirring or ruffling foot, gather your ruffle so that it measures approximately 56".

Take your 15" pillow top and put it right side up on a piece of batting that measures at least 16 x 16". Sew the pillow top to the batting $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge on all four sides. Ouilt if desired.

With raw edges even, and using a slightly larger than a ¼" seam allowance, stitch the ruffle onto the pillow top on all four sides.

Pin your ruffle to the pillow top in the corners, so that it stays in place while sewing the backing on.

Take one piece of pillow backing and fold the selvage edge back, wrong sides together, 3". Place this right sides together on your pillow top, about 4" away from one edge. Take the other back piece and place it on top of all layers, right side down, about 4" away from the opposite edge. Pin all around. Stitch from the backside of the pillow right on top of, or just inside your ruffle stitch, all around the pillow. Trim off the excess backing and batting. Flip right side out. Stuff and enjoy!
