

## **Sweet Tweets** for your Valentine

Use some pretty scraps to make a Valentine – the original social media, if you will – for a special someone in your life. The pert little bluebird will be the ideal messenger of happy and loving thoughts you write on the back. Fusible applique techniques and a charming design make this a quick project suitable to give to grandparents, teachers, BFFs and sweethearts alike.



## **MATERIALS**

2 squares of background fabric 5¼″ x 5½″ Assorted fabric scraps Fusible web Fabric pen

## **ASSEMBLY**

- Referring to the full-size pattern, prepare the bird, beak, eye, small heart, big heart and inner square for fusible applique according to the manufacturer's directions.
- Center the inner square on a background square and fuse in place. Position the remaining applique patches as shown and fuse in place. Blanket stitch around the raw edges of the applique patches (except the bird's eye) to secure them. ▶

D Prepare the remaining background square for fusible applique. Layer it on the appliqued square, wrong sides together, and fuse in place. Use a fabric pen to write a greeting on the back if desired.

Set your printer to 100% or "no scaling" before you print your pdf.

This line should measure 2".
