



GO! Project Idea Assembly Instructions

funky flowers



finished size 38" x 38"



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- White Fabric—1⅓ yards
- Black Fabric—1¼ yards (includes binding)
- Appliqué Fabrics—5 or more fat quarters
- Fusible Web—1½ yards
- Backing—11/4 yards
- Batting-44" x 44"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

White Fabric:


- Cut 13—6½" squares
- Cut 4—3½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF)

Black Fabric:

- Cut 12—61/2" squares
- Cut 4—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut $4-1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips across the WOF for inner border

Appliqué Fabrics:

Cut a total of 29 large flower shapes, about 11 small flowers and 29 flower centers with fusible web backing



GO! Dies also used:

- Strip Cutter-31/2" (55032)
- Strip Cutter-21/2" (55017)
- Strip Cutter-11/2" (55024)
- Squares-61/2" (55000)

SEWING DIRECTIONS

- 1. Layout black and white 6½" squares in a checkerboard design.
- Pin and sew squares into rows. Press seams toward black squares.
- 3. Pin and sew rows together to form quilt center. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
- 4. Add 1½" black inner border, adding the sides first, then top and bottom. Press seams toward inner border.
- 5. Add 3½" white outer border, adding the sides first, then top and bottom. Press seams toward inner border.
- 6. Remove paper backings from appliqué shapes.
- 7. Position groupings of five large flowers on quilt using diagram for inspiration. Add small flowers and flower centers. Fuse according to manufacturer's directions.
- 8. Position and fuse one flower and flower center on corners of inner border.
- 9. Machine appliqué edges of appliqué shapes.

QUILTING & FINISHING

- 1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
- 4. Add binding, mitering corners.
