# **Cutting Instructions:**

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

# Fabric A - Toscana Picket Fence (White):

- (4) 4.5" X WOF strips. Subcut (12) 12.5" X 4.5" rectangles.
- (2) 9.5" X WOF strips. Subcut (4) 18.5" X 9.5" rectangles.
- •(1) 10.5" X WOF strip. Subcut (2) 10.5" X 10.5" squares and (4) 8.5" X 4.5" rectangles.
- (1) 8.5" X WOF strip. Subcut (4) 8.5" X 4.5" rectangles and (4) 4.5" X 4.5" squares.

# Fabric B - Clusters Purple:

• (7) 2.5" x WOF strips for binding.

#### Fabric C- Tossed Lilacs Lavender:

• (16) 4.5" X 4.5" squares.

## Fabric D- Clusters Green:

• (2) 9.25" X 9.25" squares and (8) 9.5" X 9.5" squares.

# Fabric E- Small Blooms Purple:

• FIRST cut (1) 10.5" X 10.5" square and (2) 9.25" X 9.25" squares. From remaining fabric, cut (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.

# Fabric F- Tonal Vines Lavender:

• (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.

# Fabric G - Small Blooms White:

• (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.

# Fabric H - Floating Small Blooms White:

• (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.

### Fabric I - Packed Lilacs Purple:

• (2) 10.5" X 10.5" squares.

#### Fabric J - Tonal Vines Green

• (1) 10.5 X 10.5" square.

# Fabric K - Packed Lilacs White:

• (2) 10.5" X 10.5" squares.



#### Week 1 fabrics:

- E (1) 10.5" X 10.5" square
- J (1) 10.5" X 10.5" square.
- K (2) 10.5" X 10.5" square.

## General Instructions:

All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.


1. Use E & J squares. Cut each square diagonally from corner to corner (both sides) to create (4) triangles from each square. With RST, place **GREEN** on the **bottom** and **PURPLE** on the **top** as shown. Stitch right side as shown. Carefully open and press seams open. (Fig. 1). Make 4.











2. Use K squares. Cut each square once, diagonally from corner to corner. Finger press RST to mark center. Match center of K triangles to center seam of E/J triangles. Stitch and press. Trim completed blocks to 9.5" X 9.5". (Fig. 2). Make 4.

3. Arrange as shown. Stitch and press. Finished block should measure 18.5" X 18.5". (Fig. 3). Make 1.




# General Instructions:


All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.


1. Use (A) & (I) 10.5" X 10.5" squares. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of A squares. Place squares RST. Stitch 1/4" on either side of drawn lines. Cut on drawn line. Carefully open. Press & trim to 9.5" X 9.5" squares. (Fig. 1). Make 4.



**2**. Use (A) 18.5" X 9.5" rectangles and (D) 9.5" X 9.5" squares. Draw lines corner to corner on wong side of all D squares. With RST, sew D blocks to upper left corners of all A rectangles, stitching on drawn line. Trim & press. Sew remaining D blocks to upper right corners, stitching on drawn line. Trim & press. Blocks should measure 18.5" X 9.5". Make 4.







# Week 2 fabrics:

- A (12) 12.5" X 4.5" rectangles.
- E (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.
- F (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.
- G (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.
- H (24) 4.5" X 3.5" rectangles.

# General Instructions:

All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

1. Use E, F, G, H rectangles. Arrange as shown. Sew (24) sets together on the 4.5" sides. (Fig. 1). Make 24.

**2**. Using A rectangles, sew "piano keys" to top and bottom of each rectangle as shown. Finished block should measures 12.5" X 12.5". (Fig. 2). **Make 12**.



- A (4) 4.5" X 4.5" squares, (8) 8.5 X 4.5" rectangles.
- C (16) 4.5" X 4.5" squares.
- D (2) 9.25" X 9.25" squares.
- E (2) 9.25" X 9.25" squares.


# General Instructions:

All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

1. Use D & E squares. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on wrong side of D squares. Place squares RST. Stitch 1/4" on either side of drawn lines. Cut on drawn line. Carefully open. Press & trim to 8.5" X 8.5" squares. (Fig. 1). Make 4.











2. Use (A) 8.5" X 4.5" rectangles and (C) 4.5" X 4.5" squares. Draw lines corner to corner on wong side of all C squares. With RST, sew C blocks to upper left corners of all A rectangles, stitching on drawn line. Trim & press. Sew remaining C blocks to upper right corners, stitching on drawn line. Trim & press. Blocks should measure 8.5" X 4.5". Make 8.








**3**. Using (A) 4.5" X 4.5" squares and completed blocks from steps 1 & 2 - arrange as show. Sew together. Block should measure 12.5" X 12.5". (Fig. 3). **Make 4.**

# **Quilt Assembly**

#### Week 5 fabrics:

• B - (7) 2.5" X WOF strips (Binding).

# General Instructions:

All seams are 1/4" unless otherwise noted. RST= right sides together. Press seams as preferred.

- 1. Use completed blocks from previous weeks. Arrange center star block as shown. (Fig. 1) Assemble the star in rows, then sew rows together from top to bottom. Completed star should measure 36.5" X 36.5".
- 2. Stitch (2) sets of 3 Piano Keys blocks for sides of star. Use the image below for placement. Sew one set of Piano Keys to the left side of the center star, then sew the other set to the right side of the center star. This completes Row 2 in the image below. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Using the image below for placement stitch Row 1 and Row 3 together. (Fig. 1)
- **4**. Stitch completed Rows 1-3 together from top to bottom.
- 5. Quilt & bind as desired.


