Tutorial: Log Cabin Christmas Tree Quilt

Materials List

Fabrics (100% cotton quilting weight):

Greens: 3 yards total (various shades for tree realism).

Reds/Golds: 2 yards each (for ornaments, logs, and binding).

Background: 4 yards cream/white (for logs and negative space).

Christmas prints: 1 yard (for appliqués and accents).

Backing: 7 yards (solid red or green).

Batting: 90" x 90" (cotton or wool blend).

Tools:

o Rotary cutter, ruler (6" x 24"), self-healing mat.

o Freezer paper (for appliqué templates).

o Invisible thread (for appliqué).

Walking foot for sewing machine.

Step 1: Cutting (All Measurements in Inches)

Log Cabin Strips:

Cut 168 strips: 2.5" x 6.5" (background) + 2.5" x 6.5" (red/gold).

Christmas Tree Center Block:

o Cut 1 square: 24" x 24" (green fabric for tree base).

Appliqués:

- Cut circles (1.5" diameter) from red/gold prints (20 total).
- o Cut 1 star (3" wide) from gold fabric.

Step 2: Create the Tree Center Block

1. **Draw Tree Outline:** On the 24" green square, sketch a pine tree with jagged, uneven edges (height: 20").

2. Appliqué Ornaments:

Pin circles randomly on the tree.

- Stitch with invisible thread using a narrow zigzag stitch.
- 3. Add Star: Appliqué the gold star to the treetop.
- 4. Attach Batting: Layer tree block + batting + backing square. Baste with safety pins.



Step 3: Log Cabin Assembly (Quilt-as-You-Go)

- First "Log" (Directly on Tree Block):
 - Sew a 2.5" x 6.5" background strip to the right side of the tree block (right sides together). Press open.
 - o Add batting + backing under the strip, then quilt along the seam.

Build Logs Sequentially:

- o Rotate block, add next log (red/gold), quilt immediately.
- Repeat, alternating background and colored strips, growing outward (total 7 rounds per block).
- o *Tip:* Vary fabric shades for depth.



Step 4: Join Blocks & Final Quilting

- Assemble Top: Sew 9 completed blocks (3x3 grid) into the queen top (finished size: 84" x 84").
- Border: Add 3" red print borders to all sides.
- All-Over Quilting: Stitch wavy lines (snow) in the background areas.

Step 5: Binding

- Cut 8 strips (2.5" x WOF), join diagonally.
- Attach to quilt front with walking foot, miter corners.
- Hand-stitch to backing for invisible finish.
