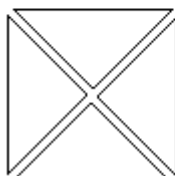
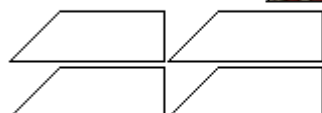
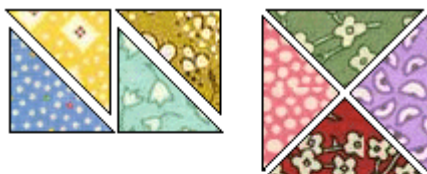
This makes an 10" block!

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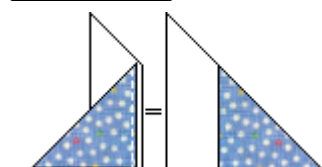

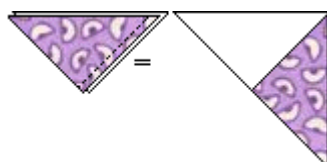
** Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block **



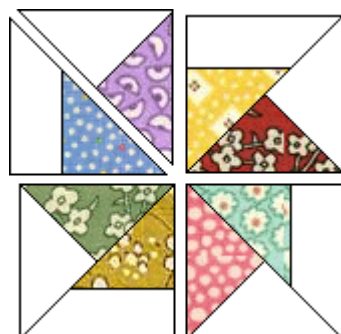
Using the templates provided, cut four different print half square triangles-HST ($4\frac{3}{8}$ "), four different print quarter square triangles($6\frac{1}{4}$ "), four white trapezoids ($2" \times 5\frac{7}{8}$ ") and four white quarter square triangles ($6\frac{1}{4}"$)...



Using a $\frac{1}{4}"$ seam, sew a trapezoid to each half square triangle, pressing seams to darker sides...



Sew each print quarter square triangle to a white quarter square triangle, again pressing to the darker side...



Now pair a half square triangle unit to each quarter square triangle unit, pressing seams to one side. Join these four quadrants to complete your Pinwheel #8 block!...[on to Page 2!](#)
